# **Uniform Expectations**

We would like to thank parents for supporting school in maintaining such high standards of school uniform since we returned in September. We also appreciate how difficult it has been to source appropriate school shoes whilst retail outlets are still closed. As shops begin to open again, we will be re-establishing our rules around school shoes and will be expecting all pupils to wear black shoes or boots or black leather trainers to school (unless an alternative has been agreed with the Headteacher). Trainers must be leather, not fabric and be only black in colour (including the sole). Pupils may bring a change of shoes for playtimes.



PE Kit should be in school every day so that we can maximise the amount of physical activity that is on offer to all pupils. This should be brought in on a Monday and kept on their school peg.



If you need support with uniform or PE kit we have some 'preloved' clean uniform and kits in school that we can give to any pupils who require it. Contact Mrs Wragg or the admin team at school who can support with this.

- Year 6 Transition During the summer term, we will be supporting our Year 6 pupils in their transition to secondary school. This will include activities to prepare them for the changes ahead as well as school visits and celebrations which parents will be invited to join in with.
- Doncaster Council Traffic Enforcement Team will be supporting Spa Academy in creating a safer environment around school. From Monday 12<sup>th</sup> April a camera will be in place to enforce safe parking, including on school 'keep clear' markings and bus stops. School council will continue to promote this.
