
Year 5 Residential Visit Monday 20th - Wednesday 22nd March 2023

Tuesday 21st March - at Kingswood:


- Up and dressed.

Meals:


- All meals are two courses.

- Friends together ©
- Bunk beds.
- 4 staff going and their rooms are near pupils' rooms.
- We look after pupils all night and day.
- NO electronic devices (phones, tablets, ipads etc.) are allowed to be taken onto the site.
