At the end of **Year 6**, all pupils across the country sit their **SATs**. These are national end of Key Stage 2 assessments in **reading, grammar & spelling and maths** (as well as teacher assessments in **writing**). We are holding an information session for parents on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> January at 3pm to share ideas and tips on how to support your child.

Since November, our Y6 pupils have been demonstrating **responsibility**, **dedication** and **determination** by attending weekly **booster sessions** to increase both their confidence and subject knowledge, ahead of the tests in May. It is fantastic to see the progress pupils are making and this is being rewarded every week with our **"I'm a Y6 get me out of here!"** reward challenge (see attached poster for more information). It has been brilliant to see them taking responsibility for their own learning and showing they are Year 7 ready!

SATs week runs Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May to Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2024. The tests can only be taken during this week at the dates and times set by the Government. With this in mind, pupils are not allowed to take holidays during this week.

**Communication Updates:** Thank you to all who completed the communication survey. We have analysed the responses and the main findings are as follows:

- Text is the most useful form of communication

Moving forwards, we will use text messaging as the main form of communication. We will also ensure all dates are sent out on our Newsletter, as well as reminders at least one week before days/events take place.

**School Day:** As you are aware we recently consulted with our school community on an extension to the school day, namely up to an additional 30 minutes at the end of the day. I am pleased to report the majority of responses received were positive and in favour of the extension. Having already consulted with staff, our next step is to consult with our local infant and secondary academies. Many of our families have children who attend across multiple settings so please be assured that we will take this in to consideration before any decision is made.

**Academy Governing Body:** This term, Governors have continued to visit school and meet with pupils, staff & school leaders as part of their link governor roles. ### **ASPIRE**

The ASPIRE programme supports every pupil to personally develop, engaging with interests beyond the academic curriculum.
